#### 1. Call to Order

#### 2. Introductions – Welcome our Executive Director, Donald Killorn!

- Chair Jessica Bibza requested that any new attendees introduce themselves for a warm welcome.
- Amy Newbold (EPA) introduced Rick Durbrow (EPA Region 4) who has been working with FEMA as a Sustainability Advisor in St. Joe/St. Andrew/Apalachicola watersheds and is currently working on a project called the "Recovery and Resiliency Partnership".
- Logan McDonald (PPBEP) introduced Jenny Paul (EPA), an ORISE fellow Region 4/GEMMD. She will be assisting the program with CCMP Development as well as working closely with Janet Nestlerode (EPA).
- Brandon Jarvis (EPA) introduced his new post-doctoral researcher, Melissa Duval (EPA). She will be assisting with water quality data analyses, future publications, and hydrodynamic modeling.

## c. Legislative Appropriation

#### i. Mini Grant Update

Logan announced that all Mini Grant recipient contracts were in place and that projects are due to kick off this month and into February.

#### ii. Oyster Mapping – Escambia County

Whitney provided an update on the future oyster mapping effort that is due to get underway in the coming months.

- Continuation of Santa Rosa County mapping lead by TNC Oyster group, but focus on Escambia and Pensacola Bays
- Will provide PPBEP and partners with full picture of current spatial extent and condition of oysters in the Pensacola Bay system

#### iii. NCCA/NWCA

Whitney provided updates on the progress of intensifications for EPA watershed surveys.

 National Coastal Condition Assessment (NCCA) intensification kicking off week of June 7!

- PPBEP preparing for intensification for the National Wetlands Condition Assessment (NWCA) with a focus on estuarine wetlands.
- Dr. Matt Deitch (UF) is taking the lead for this effort and will bring on colleagues to assist.
- Training will be In-Person at the GEMMD Gulf Breeze Lab week of April 19th

    - 1. Coastal Resilience: Planning for resilience in the Perdido Bay System through modeling shoreline trends and improving shoreline suitability tools.
