1. Call to Order

2. Roll Call

M. Posner called the roll. A quorum was present.

3. Approval of March 30, 2022, Policy Board Minutes

Commissioner Piech (Santa Rosa County) made a motion to approve the March 30, 2022 meeting minutes. Mayor Fitch (Gulf Breeze) seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The internship update was moved to the top of the agenda so that interns could introduce themselves to the board. Summer of 2022 Interns Sarah Jacobs (Development), Caitlin Jennings (Community Resilience), Molly McDaniel (Community Resilience), and Tucker Reynolds (Manatee Outreach) introduced themselves to the board.

Following the internship update, Commissioner Bender (Escambia County) requested to move through the action items before the staff update.

4. Action Items

a. Approval of the Mississippi-Alabama SeaGrant Consortium Subrecipient Agreement, for \$28,496, for the Resilience Readiness Project

Mayor Fitch (City of Gulf Breeze) made a motion to approve the Subrecipient Agreement, for \$28,496, from the Mississippi-Alabama SeaGrant Consortium; request the Escambia County Board of County Commissioners, as the host agency of PPBEP, accept the Agreement on behalf of PPBEP; and authorize the Executive Director to execute the Agreement and carry out the scope of work. Commissioner Piech (Santa Rosa County) seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

- b. Approval of Florida Department of Environmental Protection Grant Agreement No. 22PLN35, for \$687,500, for the Compound Flood Modeling and Adaptation Planning Project
 Councilperson Ann Hill (City of Pensacola) made a motion to accept the award of \$687,500 from the Resilient Florida Grant Program; approve the draft scope of work (subject to minor modifications); request the Escambia County Board of County Commissioners, as the host agency of PPBEP, accept the Agreement on behalf of PPBEP; and authorize the Executive Director to execute the Agreement and carry out the scope of work. Mayor Fitch (City of Gulf Breeze) seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- c. Approval of a Letter of Support for PPBEP's Application to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection Regional Resilience Entity Grant Program

Councilperson Hill (City of Pensacola) made a motion to approve the Letter of Support for PPBEP's application to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection Regional Resilience Entity Grant Program and authorize the Chairman to sign the letter. Mike Norberg (Okaloosa County) seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Woody Speed (City of Orange Beach) asked M. Posner for a description of the DEP Regional Resilience Entity Grant Program. M. Posner informed the board that the Regional Resilience Entity Grant Program was established by the resilient Florida legislation to support multijurisdictional climate adaptation and resilience-building efforts. This letter of support will accompany PPBEP's application to the Resilience Entity Grant Program.



d. Approval of an Agreement with Impact Campaigns, for \$55,000, for PPBEP Marketing Services

Woody Speed (City of Orange Beach) made a motion to approve the agreement with Impact

Campaigns, for \$55,000, for PPBEP Marketing Services; and request the Escambia County Board of

County Commissioners, as the host agency of PPBEP, award the agreement. Mayor Fitch (City of Gulf

Breeze) seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Bender (Escambia County) clarified that the Escambia County Board of County Commissioners requested that the PPBEP Policy Board act on this item before the agreement is put forth to the Board of County Commissioners. Councilperson Ann Hill (City of Pensacola) asked what kind of marketing this contract will involve. M. Posner stated that the scope of work would include support for the expansion of outreach campaigns, which will help educate residents and visitors about the PPBEP and its watersheds.

e. Approval of an Extension to the Lease Agreement with Empire Partners for PPBEP's Administrative Office Lease

Councilperson Ann Hill (City of Pensacola) made a motion to extend the PPBEP Office Space Lease
Agreement with Empire Partners from July 31, 2022, to December 31, 2022; and request the Escambia
County Board of County Commissioners, as the host agency of PPBEP, execute the lease agreement
extension. Commissioner Piech (Santa Rosa County) seconded the motion and the motion passed
unanimously.

- f. Approval of FY22-23 Local Government Contributions Request Letter

 Councilperson Ann Hill (City of Pensacola) made a motion to approve the request letter for each
 governing body within the Pensacola and Perdido Bays Estuary Program to contribute for FY22-23.

 Mayor Fitch (City of Gulf Breeze) seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
- g. Approval of the Amended and Restated PPBEP Interlocal Agreement

 PPBEP requested to drop action item g to allow for additional due diligence with Florida Department of

 Economic Opportunity (DEO). It will be added to the July Policy Board agenda for discussion.
- h. Approval of the Amended PPBEP Board Bylaws

Commissioner Bender (Chair, Escambia County) requested to drop action item h in relation to the clarification of adding the state of Alabama to the financial disclosure section 6.2. Approval of the PPBEP bylaws will be added to the July Policy Board agenda.

- 5. Staff Updates

 The Finance Sub-Committee did not have action items to discuss before the May Policy Board meeting. The committee will reconvene before the June Policy Board meeting. The Expenditure Report was included, and the grants are tracking on target.
 - ii. EPA Budget Amendment Update



Requested budget modifications to EPA RESTORE and the EPA Trash Free Waters grants have been approved by the EPA.

iii. NEP Designation Legislation

NEP designation is moving forward with support from Senator Rubio and Senator Scott's office and the City of Orange Beach. A trip to Washington D.C. was discussed to gain additional support for the NEP designation.

iv. Governance Structure Transition Update

PPBEP is continuing to work with DEO's Independent Special District Accountability Program to ensure administrative services (financial services, general counsel, and IT support) are accounted for in the transition.

v. Local Government Contributions

Local government contributions will serve as required match for several federal funding opportunities. Staff and partners are preparing for several funding opportunities that will be available through RESTORE, NRDA, and the Federal Infrastructure Bill.

vi. Management Conference Report Out

Over 100 people attended the first annual PPBEP Management Conference held on April 13th. Participant input will help staff to shape PPBEP's annual work plan priorities.

b. **Technical Update** (Whitney Scheffel, Senior Scientist)

i. CCMP Development Status, Schedule, and Next Steps

- PPBEP is working with Background Stories to design the CCMP. Draft documents have been submitted to the designers.
- A draft will be available for review by committees and the Policy Board in July. Additional public comment will be sought after the draft is finalized.
- Staff will present the final draft for Policy Board approval in September.

ii. NOAA Actionable Science Seagrass Workshop

- Staff and partners hosted a seagrass workshop at the Perdido Key Community
 Center with experts to collaborate on the execution of the program's actionable
 science grant. The workshop input will support the development of a strategic
 plan to build seagrass resilience through genetic strategies.
- The second phase of the funding cycle will open later this summer and support the implementation of selected projects over the next five years.

c. **Outreach Update** (Logan McDonald, Community Outreach Coordinator)

i. Community Grant Update

The Community Grant Program funding cycle concludes on May 31st, with final reports due in June. Staff will provide a comprehensive update on all the Community Grant Program funded projects in July.

• The Perdido Key Coastal Demonstration Garden (Escambia County) was planted



with the help of many volunteers. Educational signage will inform the public about the garden and how they can incorporate these practices into their own properties.

- The EscaRosa OysterCorps Program (Franklins Promise) has been working with Pace High School students to care for marsh plants and recently planted Saltmeadow Cordgrass (Spartina patens) along the shoreline at Floridatown Park.
- The UWF Historical Ecology Project hosted two seminars to share information on their research findings. A seminar at the Perdido Methodist Church informed the public about the history of oysters in the Perdido Bay system. The second seminar was held at Odd Colony in Pensacola and highlighted the history and legacy of some of the waterways and tributaries in the Pensacola Bay system.
- PPBEP tentatively plans to open applications for the 2022-2023 funding cycle on July 6th, pending final approval of the state budget by the Governor.

ii. Trash Free Waters (Emerson Cheney, TFW Volunteer Coordinator)

- Staff are implementing Trash Free Waters curriculum and hosting field trips with students.
- PPBEP celebrated National Travel and Tourism Week with a tourism gives back cleanup at Jones Creek with Visit Pensacola, Keep Pensacola Beautiful, and Clean Horizons.
- Litter boom monitoring is approaching the one-year anniversary.
- Staff are organizing a future workshop to share the litter data and gather community input on litter prevention solutions for each of the creek systems.

iii. UWF CETES Students

• UWF CETES students completed their projects that supported PPBEP through video support for events, K-12 Trash Free Waters curriculum, stormwater mural projects, and the development of a local brewery proceeds competition.

<u>Background:</u> The PPBEP Interlocal Agreement and Board Bylaws require approval of an annual budget prior to the start of the new fiscal year on October 1st of each year.

While the budget overall is relatively stable compared to the current fiscal year, two important changes should be noted to the Board. First, two additional positions are budgeted in fiscal year 2022-2023. This includes the addition of a Finance Manager and Resilience Coordinator positions. These two additional positions will incur an approximately \$124,000 increase in personnel expenses. The Finance Manager will be funded through local government contributions and indirect funds. The Resilience Coordinator position is currently grant funded.

Secondly, the administrative services line item is a \$67,500 increase to the operating budget to cover services currently provided by the Estuary Program's host agency, Escambia County. It is anticipated legal services will be provided pro bono to the Estuary Program, though a placeholder expense has been included in the event pro bono services do not materialize.

Staff will ensure operational cost saving measures are incorporated where feasible that do not result in reduction of services provided by the Estuary Program.

<u>Recommendation:</u> Recommend the Board accept the Finance Subcommittee's recommendation and approve the FY 2022-2023 PPBEP operating budget.

<u>Financial Impact:</u> The proposed FY 2022-2023 PPBEP operating budget of \$761,420 will be funded through local, state, and federal government contributions, grants, and donations.

<u>Background:</u> Currently, the Escambia County Natural Resources Department's Accounting Office provides all financial management support for the Estuary Program. As the Program prepares for a hosting structure transition in fiscal year 2022-2023, the Estuary Program will be required to take on these critical administrative duties, including processing invoices, payroll, grant reimbursements, etc.

Staff is recommending the creation of a new Finance Manager position in FY22-23 to oversee these duties in addition to aiding the Executive Director with procurement, administrative functions, and compliance with state and federal requirements.

This position is budgeted in the proposed FY22-23 budget in the amount of \$49,920 in salary plus \$17,472 in benefits, for a total of \$67,392. If approved by the full Board, staff proposes onboarding this position in fall 2022 to aid in the organizational transition.

Position Responsibilities:

- Ensure bills are paid in a timely and accurate manner, consistent with PPBEP procedures.
- Coordinate with PPBEP's contracted accounting services provider to process transactions, payroll, record entries, prepare quarterly financial reports, facilitate internal audits, and reconcile fund accounts.
- Collaborate with PPBEP staff to maintain accurate, up-to-date records of incoming and outgoing payments; initiate work requisitions and reimbursements; and track fund balances.
- Analyze financial statements and find discrepancies that require management's attention.
- Assist management with development of budget forecasts.
- Assist with maintaining efficient programmatic operations including coordination of office and equipment leases, staff travel and equipment procurement, and general office operations.

Minimum Qualifications:

➤ Bachelor's degree in Accounting, Business Administration, Public Administration or related field and at least two years experience; or an equivalent combination of relevant education and experience.

<u>Recommendation:</u> Recommend the Board accept the Finance Subcommittee's recommendation and approve the creation of a Finance Manager Position.

<u>Financial Impact:</u> Funding is currently available in Program reserves from unallocated local government contributions.

<u>Background:</u> Currently, the Escambia County Natural Resources Department's Accounting Office provides all financial management support for the Estuary Program and the Escambia County Clerk's Office processes all payments. As the Program prepares for a hosting structure transition in fiscal year 2022-2023, the Estuary Program will be required to take on these critical administrative duties.

Staff is recommending the issuance of a solicitation for accounting services to assist with purchasing, accounts payable, journal entries, report retrieval; maintain financial records and reports; maintain books, records, documents, invoices; permit all such records to be subject to inspection, review, and audit; record all cash disbursements and cash receipts; track income and expenses in the accounting system; prepare invoices and track receivables; allocate payroll; record month-end journal entries; reconcile bank and credit card statements and provide monthly report; prepare financial statements; assist in preparation of budgets and reports; assist with annual budget development; maintain accurate chart of accounts; coordinate and provide support to auditor.

\$30,000 is budgeted in the proposed FY22-23 budget. If approved by the full Board, staff proposes issuing this solicitation in fall 2022 to aid in the organizational transition. Scope and cost are anticipated to change dependent on the approval of the proposed Finance Manager position and qualifications of the selected applicant.

<u>Recommendation:</u> Recommend the Board accept the Finance Subcommittee's recommendation and approve issuing a solicitation for accounting services.

<u>Financial Impact:</u> Funding is currently available in Program reserves from unallocated local government contributions.

<u>Background:</u> The Executive Director will accompany Mayor Robinson on travel to Washington, D.C. between July 27th and 29th, 2022 to meet with Congressional and agency representatives to provide an update on PPBEP accomplishments to date, priorities for FY22-23, and discuss National Estuary Program designation status.

<u>Recommendation:</u> Recommend the Board approve the Executive Director to travel to Washington, D.C. for legislative and agency meetings.

<u>Financial Impact:</u> Travel funding is currently budgeted in the FY21-22 operating budget. This trip is estimated to cost approximately \$1,200.

<u>Background:</u> The Executive Director has been accepted into the University of Florida's Natural Resources Leadership Institute (NRLI) as a Fellow of Class 22. NRLI is a specialized leadership training program geared toward natural resource professionals. NRLI's mission is to bring together professionals from sectors that impact or are impacted by natural resources issues and provide them with the training required to find inclusive solutions to seemingly intractable problems. This eight course program will feature a variety of natural resource challenges across the state. The program begins in August 2022 and will wrap up in April 2023.

<u>Recommendation:</u> Recommend the Board approve reimbursement of registration fees, in the amount of \$4,500, for the Executive Director to participate in the University of Florida Natural Resources Leadership Institute Program.

<u>Financial Impact:</u> Professional development funding is available in the EPA Grant Budget in the amount of \$12,000.

Proposal Categories:

Water Quality: Achieve water quality improvement in one or both bay systems and/or their associated waterways to reduce nutrients and bacteria.

(Examples: "best management practices" for agriculture; innovative retention/filtering techniques)

Sedimentation: Reduce sediment loading by identifying and/or addressing root causes and sources. (Examples: sedimentation monitoring or fingerprinting; erosion impact assessment)

Habitat Restoration: Restore and/or enhance native habitat(s) to achieve sustainable and healthy systems.

(Examples: restoration of natural shorelines/enhancement of seawalls; planning/action projects addressing oysters, seagrasses, coastal and freshwater wetlands, and other estuarine habitats)

Fish and Wildlife Conservation: Reduce threats to native fish and wildlife through the protection of natural resources.

(Examples: awareness of threats to wildlife from monofilament line; protection of seagrass beds; education on fish and wildlife habitat)

(Examples: programs that directly involve youth in solutions to bay problems; programs directed at disadvantaged youth, homeowner education around smart fertilizer or living shorelines)

Resilience: Promote capacity building and/or construct pilot resilience demonstration projects, such as living shorelines, green infrastructure, or low impact development.

(Examples: projects that address historic and/or persistent environmental inequalities related to water resources and/or local water quality; living shoreline and green infrastructure demonstration projects)

Community Science: Engage community members through hands-on community science to provide data on watershed conditions.

(Examples: Water quality monitoring; habitat monitoring; or field research that engages community members)

Match:

Match is not required but is strongly encouraged. Projects that include cash or in-kind match, to include volunteer labor, will receive greater consideration.

Selection Criteria:

CCMP Action Plan Alignment (20)

The proposed project should align with the PPBEP's draft CCMP Action Plan. The proposal should explicitly state which Goals and Actions will be supported through the proposed work. Proposal categories are based off of the CCMP Action Plan.

Project Approach (20)

Applicant should describe in detail the project scope of work, need, objectives, and deliverables. Specifically, the strength of the program will be evaluated on the originality of the proposed project and the extent to which it addresses a need or provides a benefit to the systems. Another important measure of the strength of the proposal is the likelihood that the project will be successfully implemented.

Estuary/Watershed Impact (25)

The project's goal and objectives must explicitly state how the project will target watershed and/or bay issues that result in the restoration, enhancement, and/or protection of the bay systems and associated watersheds.

Demonstration of Applicant Ability (10)

The project team must have adequate education and/or experience to carry out the project design. The team must include the necessary personnel and expertise for the project as proposed. Responsibilities and division of labor should be designated. For projects planned on public lands or facilities, applicants must obtain permission for access to or use of those lands or facilities. Permission for use of private property not controlled by applicant also is required.

Community Impact (15)

Projects must demonstrate the community impact for the project. All proposals, regardless of scope, should reflect some measure of community support. Greater consideration will be given to projects that demonstrate clear impacts within underrepresented communities.

Cost Justification (10)

Cost justification requires that the proposal and the budget give enough detail to show that costs are appropriate to the scope of work. Reimbursement will be based on expenses assigned to cost categories in a budget that must be approved by the Estuary Program before a project begins.

Selection Process:

A Selection Committee (seven members) comprised of one member of Estuary Program staff, two members of the Technical Committee, two members of the Education Committee, and two members of the Business Partnership Program, will review and rank submitted proposals based on the selection criteria outlined above. To fund a variety of projects that cover multiple areas of the PPBEP Action Plan and geographic territory, the Selection Committee may select lower ranked projects over higher ranked projects based on the numeric ranking criteria as outlined above. The Committee will make a formal recommendation, by way of staff, to the Policy Board for approval of the shortlisted proposals. Any member serving on the Selection Committee will forfeit the right to submit or partner on a submitted Community Grant Proposal.

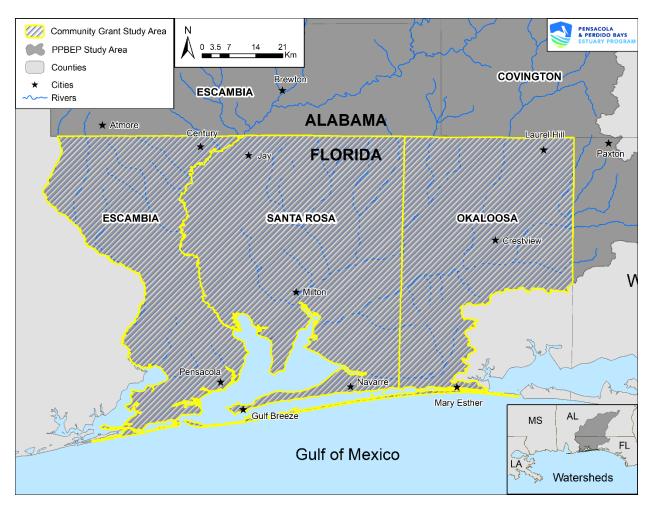


Figure 1: Projects located in the Pensacola or Perdido Bays Watersheds within Escambia, Santa Rosa, and/or Okaloosa counties are eligible
